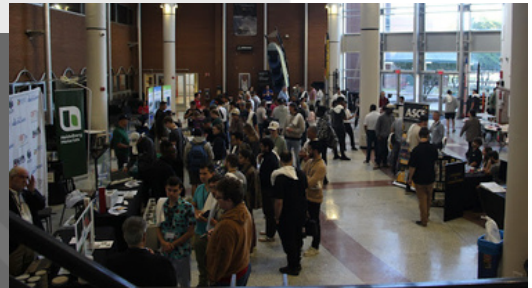
SOUTHEAST STUDENT SYMPOSIUM
